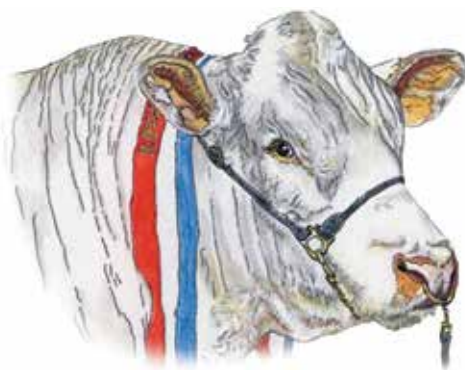

Jason and Sue extend a very warm welcome to everyone attending this year's Annual Bull Sale at Bexley. We also welcome clients who may be participating in the sale via AuctionsPlus.

The season here through summer was patchy and a case of some being under storms with good rain and those who unfortunately missed out. As time moves on we have seen outstanding rains right up the East Coast of NSW and QLD with these rain bands entering inland giving most of us on the North West Slopes very good Autumn and Winter feed. In turn we are seeing positivity in the cattle market and cattle prices on the rise accordingly.

There are four sires represented in the sale this year. New bloodlines on offer include Venturon Raise The Bar' who was purchased from WA in 2023 for a then record price of \$36,000. This bull was also sashed Grand Champion Charolais Bull at Sydney Royal 2023. We hope you agree he has bred a very consistent line of bulls in this year's draft.

We also have Rosedale Raphael, a Red Factor bull who was top price at their sale in 2023. He was purchased to compliment our Red Factor program and has bred some very handy sons in this year's line up.

History

1972 - 2025

Our breeding up of the Minnie-Vale herd started in 1972 on a property called Mistletoe at Singleton. We had two properties there and it was here 15 young Friesian yearling females were purchased as the foundation of our breeding up program. It took many years and the stud was actually called Mistletoe with a prefix of DGS. We then moved, cattle and all, to the property Minnie-Vale at Denman, thus the stud name was changed to Minnie-Vale and the prefix became SGS.

At Singleton we were greatly influenced by our dear neighbours, Col & Joan Vickers, Glendyr Charolais, we admired their cattle so much and they were our guiding light. The other two people and great friends were Bruce and Lane Kerswell, their stud was Black Mountain Charolais, Scone, and from here on, we became so involved in the Charolais breed, promotion and trying to find the market we needed for the breed as a terminal sire in a very tough one. Cross breeding was in its infancy and we were part of it, not easy!

We formed a group with Bruce and Lane, Col and Joan, Doug and I and Col Kelly, the Hunter and New England Group. We went to all the field days all over the place promoting this wonderful breed. This group was the foundation of the Northern Breeders Group whose success was extraordinary. Doug was Chairman and also Chairman of the NSW Region on the Federal Council at the time.

We then moved to a property called Wirindi at Manilla, it was here that the cattle showing started. Jason at this stage was not home for a year or so having gone to Canada as the Australian Charolais Society representative to work on Canadian Charolais member's properties and major grain producers. He returned and finished his degree in Agriculture at Orange. At this stage Pippa and Amber was still at school in Sydney.

Our two walking sires were Mandalong Layman (P) and the French influence Ayr Estate, both remarkable bulls and left their mark on our herd, fine haired, medium framed with plenty of constitution, milking ability and good temperament.

We sold bulls, by invitation of the Queensland region, at Rockhampton February and October sales and also Wide Bay Burnett and off the paddock at home.

We showed the cattle for 25 years and some of the highlights would be Champion of Champions in 1999 with Minnie-Vale Sundance and Palgrove Digna 55. Sundance later sold at the National Show and Sale to Moongool Charolais for \$22,000, a record at the time, this bull's history is legendary over a very long time. Then Minnie-Vale Thunderbolt winning the Horden Trophy 2000 teamed with Airlie Noisette, he later sold to Waterford Charolais and Del Connen in partnership. Two such elite awards with two different bulls back to back.

Another highlight was Minnie-Vale Deputy (P) National Grand Champion and full polled brother to Sundance who sold to Rosedale Charolais for a record price of \$35,000. A remarkable bull who bred extremely well for them.

As far as the females went we think Minnie-Vale Quist was a standout, who sold to Winchester Charolais as a heifer to Gavin and Kristie O'Brien. A spectacular cow family. Quist won the Interbreed Female at Sydney Show in 2006. At Sydney Royal 2022, her daughter Winchester Daisy Duke won the same award.

At the time, I was Chairperson of NSW, also served on the Federal Council, and very involved with the Northern Breeders Group NSW, all under the banner of promoting the Charolais breed in NSW.

We started our On-Property Sales in 2003 at "Bexley", Narrabri NSW. We retired from showing cattle in 2014 to focus our energy and concentration on striving to produce top Charolais bulls to all markets and programs, both commercial and stud. We will continue to source the best genetics on offer, both in Australia and Internationally, as our Polling program continues to moved forward, which will be represented in our sale drafts in the future.

Sale Information

Inspection: Cattle may be inspected any time prior to the sale by arrangement with the vendor or his agents.

Breeding Soundness Evaluation: All bulls offered in this sale have passed their semen test and are sold fertile. They have been examined by the veterinary consultant for structural and physical soundness.

Videos Of Sale Bulls: Videos of this year's sale bulls will be available for viewing approximately 2 weeks prior to sale day via the homepage of our website www.minnievalecharolais.com.au Alternatively, go to the AuctionsPlus website.

Supplementary Sheet: All bulls will be scanned just prior to the sale by the certified scanning technician, David Reid. The bulls will be scanned for eye muscle area, rump and rib fat, marbling (IMF%) as well as sale weight and scrotal size. Supplementary sheets will be available by Tuesday 23rd of July on our website.

Guarantee: All stock are guaranteed breeders. Any claim against the breeding ability of an animal purchased should be made in writing and accompanied by a veterinary certificate within six months of the date of sale. Any animal failing to breed may either be replaced or credit given to the value of the purchase price at the following sale. This guarantee does not include interest, expenses, costs or damages this process may incur. The purchaser is responsible.

Health: Minnie-Vale is an accredited TB and Brucellosis free herd. The Moree Department of Rural Lands, of which Minnie - Vale, Bexley is part of, is recognised as Johnes Disease Free. All sale cattle have been vaccinated with 7 in 1. All sale cattle have been back lined with Dectomax and inoculated against three day sickness. All bulls have been tested free of pestivirus. **Minnie-Vale has maintained JBAS 7 Herd Status. All this year's sale bulls have been Sire Verified and tested for MYO and BPA.**

Delivery: A delivery instruction slip must be completed in writing - stock awaiting delivery. All care will be taken, but absolutely no responsibility accepted for any injury or loss occasioned during, as a consequence of, or in relation to, any holding.

Insurance: Ownership passes at the fall of the hammer. Check with your Agent on sale day for their company insurance. It is strongly recommended that insurance be taken out for transit and maybe the first joining season.

Telephone link-up: It is advised that anyone who requires telephone link-up contact their preferred agent or Davidson Cameron & Co (Tamworth, Gunnedah or Narrabri) and they will organise accordingly.

AuctionsPlus: Our sale is conducted livestream in real time and will be interfaced on AuctionsPlus with the physical auction that is being conducted. A computer is used to bring the onsite bid price to the internet screen for remote bidders to observe. Bidders can bid on computers at their location and the bid is immediately transferred to the Auction barn and relayed to the Auctioneer. Bidding is only available if registered with AuctionsPlus. You must register online to their website at least 24 hours prior to the sale - www.auctionsplus.com.au

Rebate: 2.5% for outside agents must be in writing 24 hours prior to the sale and settling on their behalf within 7 days of the sale.

Registration and Transfer: It is the vendor's responsibility to pay for all animals to be transferred on request by the purchaser. Please notify your Agent if you wish transfer. The animal will be transferred to the purchaser through the Charolais Society of Australia Ltd, Armidale, NSW.

Refreshments: Morning tea and lunch will be provided by members of the Bingara Lions Club. All proceeds will be donated to this worthy cause.

Accommodation: There is plenty of accommodation at Inverell, Bingara, Moree and Narrabri, all within one and a half hours from Bexley for Northern and Southern visitors from across the borders.

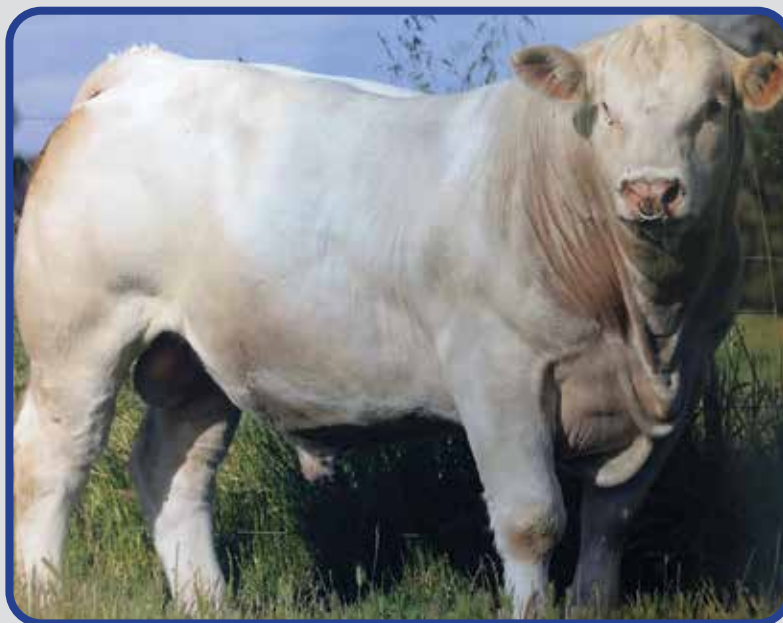

Estimated Breeding Values (EBVs) Explained

Calving Ease EBVs (%) are based on calving difficulty scores, birth weights and gestation length information. More positive EBVs are favourable and indicate easier calving.

- CE % Direct = Direct Calving Ease - The EBV for direct calving ease indicates the influence of the sire on calving ease in purebred females calving at two years of age.

- CE % Daughters = Daughters' Calving Ease - The EBV for daughters' calving ease indicates how easily that sire's daughters will calve at two years of age.

Gestation Length EBV (days) is an estimate of the time from conception to the birth of the calf and is based on Artificial Insemination and hand mating records. Lower (negative) Gestation Length EBVs indicate shorter gestation length and therefore easier calving and increased growth after birth.

Birth Weight EBV (kg) is based on the measured birth weight of progeny, adjusted for dam age. The lower the value the lighter the calf at birth and the lower the likelihood of a difficult birth. This is particularly important when selecting sires for use over heifers.

200-Day Growth EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 80 and 300 days of age. Values are adjusted to 200 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth to early ages.

400-Day Weight EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 301 and 500 days of age, adjusted to 400 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for yearling weight.

600-Day Weight EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 501 and 900 days of age, adjusted to 600 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth beyond yearling age.

Mature Cow Weight EBV (kg) is based on the cow weight when the calf is weighed for weaning, adjusted to 5 years of age. This EBV is an estimate of the genetic difference in cow weight at 5 years of age and is an indicator of growth at later ages and potential feed maintenance requirements of the females in the breeding herd. Steer breeders wishing to grow animals out to a larger weight may also use the Mature Cow Weight EBV.

Milk EBV (kg) is an estimate of an animal's milking ability. For sires, this EBV indicates the effect of the daughter's milking ability, inherited from the sire, on the 200-day weights of her calves. For dams, it indicates her milking ability.

Scrotal Size EBV (cm) is calculated from the circumference of the scrotum taken between 300 and 700 days of age and adjusted to 400 days of age. This EBV is an estimate of an animal's genetic merit for scrotal size. There is also a small negative correlation with age of puberty in female progeny and therefore selection for increased scrotal size will result in reduced age at calving of female progeny.

Carcase Weight EBV (kg) is based on abattoir carcase records and is an indicator of the genetic differences in carcase weight at the standard age of 650 days.

Eye Muscle Area EBV (sq cm) is calculated from measurements from live animal ultrasound scans and from abattoir carcase data, adjusted to a standard 300 kg carcase. This EBV estimates genetic differences in eye muscle area at the 12/13th rib site of a 300 kg dressed carcase. More positive EBVs indicate better muscling on animals. Sires with relatively higher Eye Muscle Area EBVs are expected to produce better muscled and higher percentage yielding progeny at the same carcase weight than will sires with lower Eye Muscle Area EBVs.

Rib Fat and Rump Fat EBVs (mm) are calculated from measurements of subcutaneous fat depth at the 12/13 rib site and the P8 rump site (from live animal ultrasound scans and from abattoir carcasses) and are adjusted to a standard 300 kg carcase. These EBVs are indicators of the genetic differences in fat distribution on a standard 300 kg carcase. Sires with low, or negative, fat EBVs are expected to produce leaner progeny at any particular carcase weight than will sires with higher EBVs.

Retail Beef Yield EBV (%) indicates genetic differences between animals for retail yield percentage in a standard 300 kg carcase. Sires with larger EBVs are expected to produce progeny with higher yielding carcasses.

Intramuscular Fat EBV (%) is an estimate of the genetic difference in the percentage of intramuscular fat (marbling) at the 12/13th rib site in a 300 kg carcase. Depending on market targets, larger more positive values are generally more favourable.

Selection Indices

Northern Maternal Index [NMI]- Estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for a typical commercial self-replacing herd where Charolais bulls are joined with Bos indicus cows in Northern Australia targeting the grass fed Jap Ox market. Selected heifers are retained for breeding and so maternal traits are of importance. Steers target 650 kg live weight (360 kg HSCW and 12 mm P8 fat depth) and heifers 630 kg (340 kg HSCW and 14 mm P8 fat depth), at 26 months of age. In response to industry feedback; positive emphasis has been placed on finishing ability.

Domestic Terminal Index [DTI]- Estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for a typical commercial herd where Charolais bulls are joined with a British breed cow base (e.g. Angus) targeting the domestic trade. This index assumes all progeny will be marketed with steers finished in the feedlot for 90 days, and weighing 450 kg (250 kg HSCW and 7 mm P8 fat depth) when marketed at 12 months. Heifers will be in the feedlot for 75 days, and weigh 430 kg (230 kg HSCW and 9 mm P8 fat depth) at 12 months. In response to industry feedback, positive emphasis has been placed on finishing ability.

Accuracy

Accuracy (%) is based on the amount of performance information available on the animal and its close relatives - particularly the number of progeny analysed. Accuracy is also based on the heritability of the trait and the genetic correlations with other recorded traits. Hence accuracy indicates the "confidence level" of the EBV. The higher the accuracy value the lower the likelihood of change in the animal's EBV as more information is analysed for that animal or its relatives. Even though an EBV with a low accuracy may change in the future, it is still the best estimate of an animal's genetic merit for that trait. As more information becomes available, an EBV is just as likely to increase in value, as it is to decrease.


Accuracy values range from 0-99%. The following guide is given for interpreting accuracy:

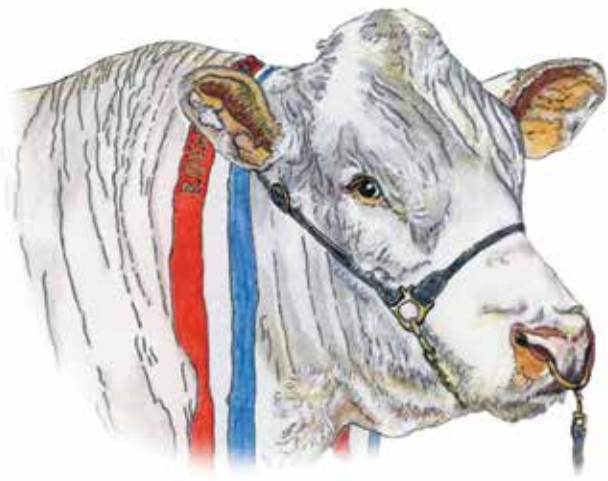
- **less than 50%: Low accuracy.** EBVs are preliminary and could change substantially as more performance information becomes available.
- **50-74%: Medium accuracy.** Usually based on the animal's own records and pedigree.
- **75-90%: Medium-high accuracy.** Some progeny information included. EBVs may change with addition of more progeny data.
- **more than 90%: High accuracy** estimate of the animal's true breeding value.

As a rule, animals should be compared on EBVs regardless of accuracy. However, where two animals have similar EBVs the one with higher accuracy could be the safer choice, assuming other factors are equal.

Points of Interest to Prospective Purchasers

- On sale day there will be signs on the pens indicating catalogue numbers.
- Quads are used for mustering all cattle. The cattle are all handled gently but firmly.
- All our cattle respect electric fencing.
- The stud does not use dogs or horses, so bulls should be introduced gently to their new environment if possible.

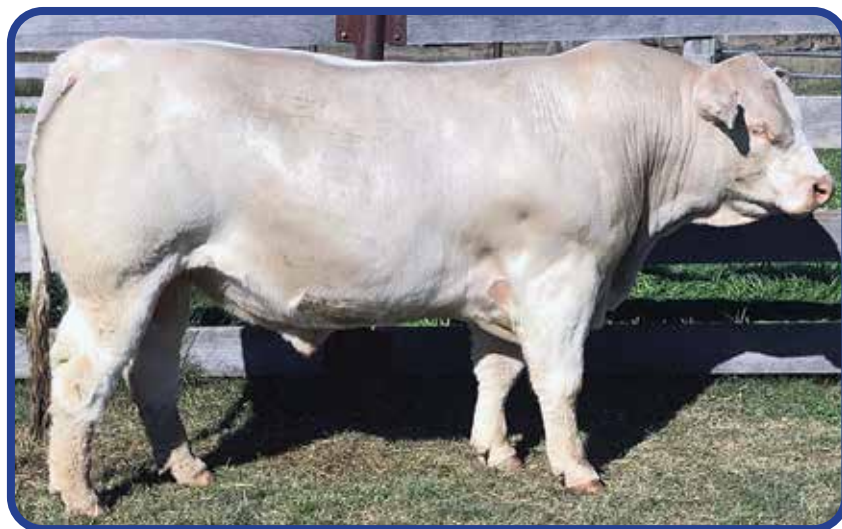

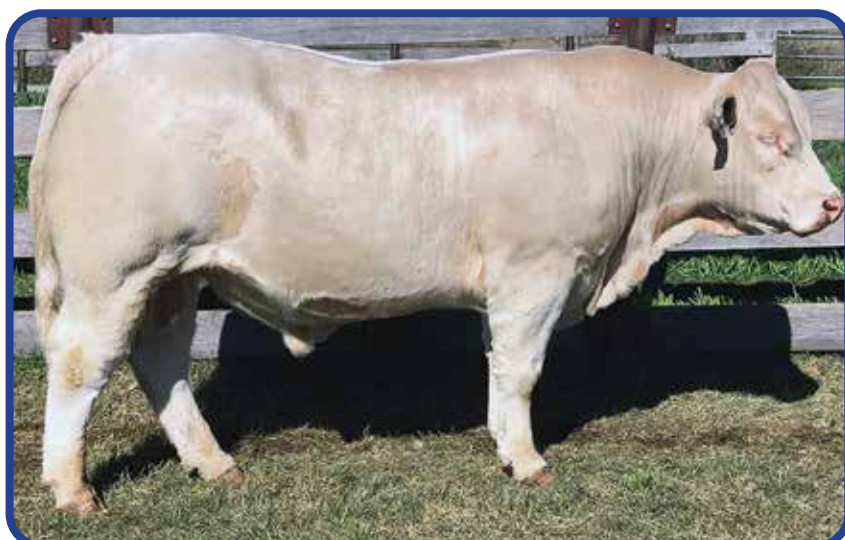

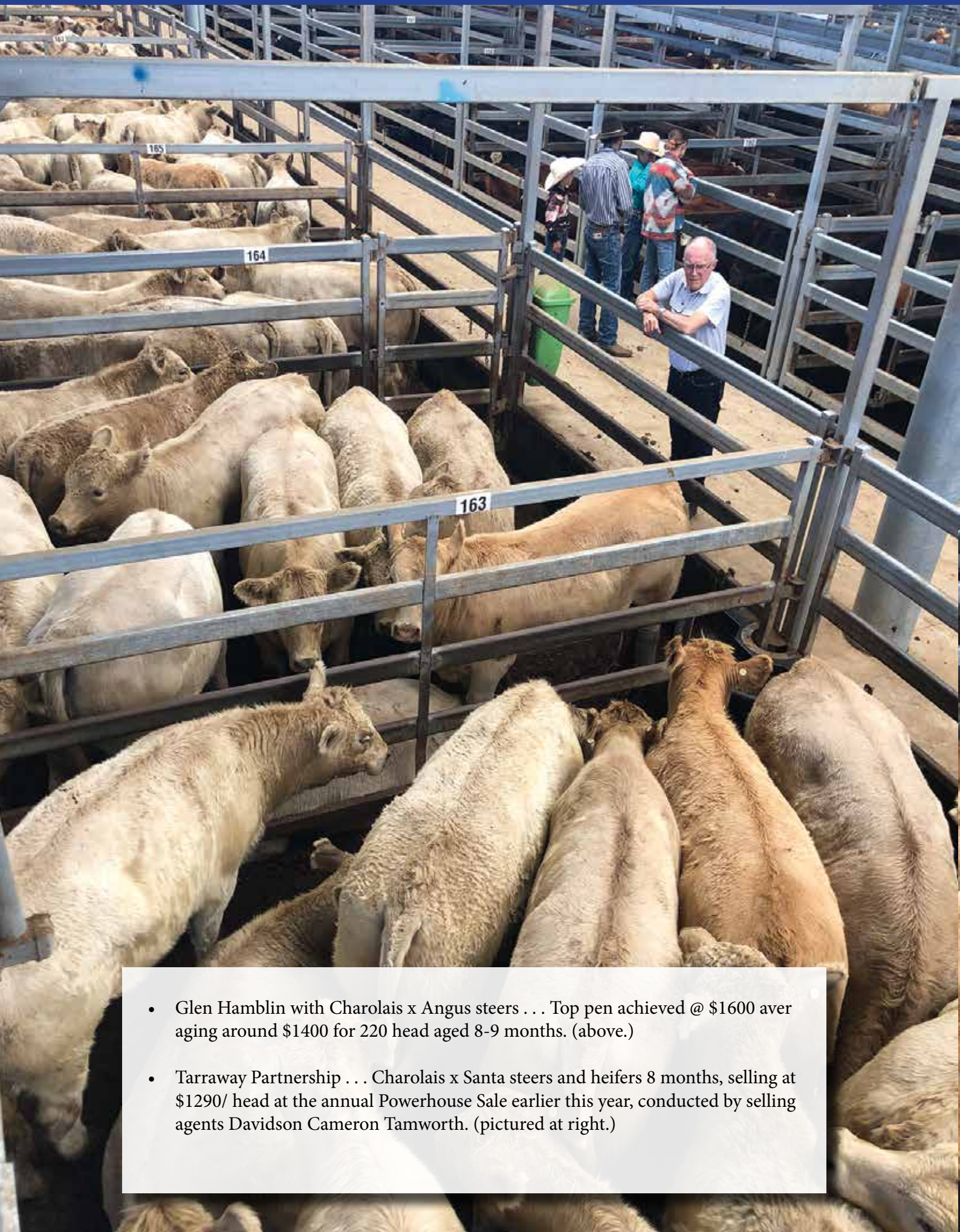
