Welcome

Our 43rd Annual Ram Sale will be held at the Warren Racecourse on Wednesday, 7 October. A total of 165 July/August 2025 drop rams will be penned on the day and ready for inspection from 9:00 am.

This year, Lots 1-45 have been individually filmed, and between Lots 46-165 a selection of random rams has been filmed to highlight the depth of the catalogue. Every ram also has an individual wool photograph available for viewing on either our website or AuctionsPlus.

Rams will be sold through the AuctionsPlus platform; however, we do recommend attending the sale or arranging for someone to purchase on your behalf on the day. We will go through the rams on 1 October if you wish to inspect the draft prior to the sale.

A very dry start for the 2025 drop, with the season becoming particularly desperate by the end of May. However, it has been a remarkable turnaround and very favourable for the Merino. In July, all rams were landed at Eenaweena and have powered ahead since.

This year, for the first time, we are excited to be offering our first poll genetics, with four specially selected rams and five flock rams. It is very pleasing to see the results of our first drop. This has been aided by breeding from the strong genetic base of the pure Egelabra ewe.

Lot 1, HEK 253128, provides clients with a fantastic opportunity to purchase a special sire and keep pace with the leading edge of our genetic progress. We will retain semen from this ram, and he will feature heavily in our AI program later this year. He has impressive pedigree, his grandsire, 200014, was sold for \$28,000 in 2021 and his sire, 223772, bred 18 reserve rams, including four special sires and 11 sale rams over the past two years. We have the same hopes for 253128. He is a tall, upstanding ram with great length of body, featuring a soft skin with long-stapled, bright white, medium wool that could handle any environment. He is a ram sure to add value to any flock.

Following the introduction of our poll genetics, Lots 16 to 165 represent the depth and consistency of the Egelabra breeding program. These quality grass-fed rams offer clients a broad selection of proven genetics, with performance and uniformity evident throughout the draft. It should be noted that the rams were shorn later than in previous years, on 16th April.

Our Merino program has stood the test of time. Knowing and understanding our environmental conditions has enabled us to adapt while focusing on our three long-term profit drivers: wool production, meat production, and surplus sheep sales. We continue to maintain a commercial focus when selecting our genetics and hone in on breeding traits that count.

Balancing the pendulum between protein (meat) and protection (wool) can be challenging, but I believe we have achieved the correct balance.

Our breeding program is also centred on producing lifetime breeding Merinos, both ewes and sires, that simply hold on and demonstrate survivability. We select for constitution and conversion while maintaining a consistent, heavy-cutting white wool clip.

Welcome

We do not breed or select based on market trends and fads. The core Merino business has enabled us to gradually expand our operation and adapt promptly to short-term fluctuations within our industry, including seasonal and market pressures.

Our Merino ewes are valuable at present and are likely to remain so for several years to come. In general, ewe numbers are decreasing due to high lamb and mutton prices, which are currently at record highs. This has placed pressure on restockers to compete, which is a positive for all Merino breeders.

In April, Egelabra held an Open Day to showcase our new poll genetics, infrastructure improvements, yards, shearing shed, and drought confinement facilities. With more than 300 visitors attending, it was fantastic to see the confidence currently present within our industry and the strong interest shown in our future direction at Egelabra.

A special thank you goes to everyone involved, particularly our Stud Manager, Duncan Lance, and Director, John Kater, for their contribution to the day.

MEASUREMENTS & SELECTION

MEASUREMENTS

Fibre Diameter (Micron): Fibre diameter is presented as the actual micron on each individual ram. Test were taken from the mid-side on the 1st August 2026.

Standard Deviation (SD): A measure (in microns) either side of the mean fibre diameter in which 68% of fibres lie.

Co-efficient of Variation (CV): Measures the spread of fibre diameter variation relative to the average. It is calculated by dividing the standard deviation (SD) by the mean fibre diameter then multiplying by 100.

Comfort Factor (CF): The percentage of fibres less than 30 microns in a sample. i.e. 100% Comfort Factor = 0% of fibres greater than 30 microns.

Greasy Fleece Weight (GFW%): This is a post weaning fleece weight taken at shearing 16/4/2026 (6mths wool growth from Tip Shearing 11/10/25) measured as a percentage relative to the average of the within flock 2025 year drop (Average = 100)

Eye Muscle Depth (EMD): This is the depth of the eye muscle, measured at the C site (45mm from centre of the spine).

Fat Depth: This is the measurement of fat depth at the C Depth. A deeper measurement indicates a fatter carcass.

Weight: Body Weight recorded 02/09/2026

SELECTION PROCEDURE

It is to be remembered that measurements provided are only one part of ram selection.

Rams must be visually acceptable for characteristics which the buyer is seeking. They must be suitable for the environment in which they are going to be used. Buyers must ensure that they are satisfied with the conformation, size, and wool type of the ram.

Having obtained the correct visual ram type the buyer can then use the measurement information as an aid in the selection of rams.

ESTIMATED BREEDING VALUES – 9 YEARS OF ANALYSIS WITHIN EGELABRA FLOCK

The Within Flock index displayed ranks the male progeny of the 2025 drop at Egelabra for the index described below. These are based on within flock rankings measured trait performance including, Yearling Body Weight, Fleece Weight, Fibre Diameter and Co-efficient of Variation. Visual assessment and individual trait performance must be considered in conjunction with the index.

A value of 100 is the median or middle of the drop. A value of 120 is 20% better, while 80 is 20% below the median.

Within Flock Merino WP Index: The index focuses on genetic improvement of fleece weight, fibre diameter, staple strength and reproduction with an emphasis on lower wrinkle.
